

HONOURABLE MR. JUSTICE SURENDRA KUMAR SINHA -CHIEF JUSTICE OF BANGLADESH

Hon`ble Justice Surendra Kumar Sinha was born on February 01, 1951 in the Village Tilakpur, P.S-Kamalganj, District-Mulvibazar. He is the son of Late Lalit Mohan Sinha and Dhanabati Sinha. Having obtained Bachelor of Laws (LLB) under Chittagong University, he was enrolled as an Advocate of the District Court, Sylhet in 1974 and practiced there under the guidance of two reputed Civil and Criminal Lawyers. He obtained the permission to practice before the High Court Division and Appellate Division of the Supreme Court of Bangladesh in 1978 and 1990 respectively. Justice Sinha was elevated as Judge of the High Court Division on 24.10.1999 and as Judge of the Appellate Division of the Supreme Court of Bangladesh on 16.07.2009. He assumed the office of the Chairman of the Bangladesh Judicial Service Commission on 12.06.2011 and the office of the Chief Justice of Bangladesh on 17.01.2015.

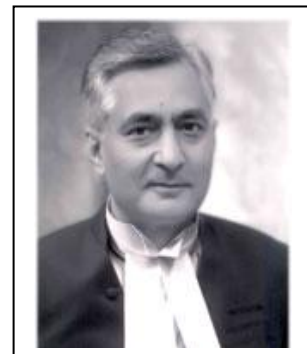


Justice Sinha represented the Chief Justice of Bangladesh in "3rd International Conference of the Chief Justices of the World" held at Lucknow, India in 2002 and presented there a paper on "Fostering respect for International Law". He participated in the "Judicial Training Programme for the Senior Judges of Bangladesh" held at Seoul, Korea in 2006. In response to an invitation from Korea International Cooperation Agency (KOICA), he participated in different Seminars on "Judicial Development Programme (Bangladesh)" from August 30 to September 14, 2010 held in Seoul, Korea and presented a Key Note on "Judicial Development of Bangladesh".

In 2012, Justice Sinha led a Bangladesh delegation to Singapore and Indonesia and took part at different meetings with the Chief Justice of Singapore and Chief Justice of Indonesia. Under the leadership of Justice Sinha, in 2013, a Bangladesh delegation visited India and United Kingdom and participated at different sessions with the Chief Justice of India, Chief Justice of Delhi High Court, Supreme Court of UK, Royal Courts of Justice, Judicial Appointments Commission in London, Judicial Appointments Board for Scotland, Lord President of Scottish High Court of Judiciary and Judicial Institute for Scotland. Being invited by the National Centre for State Courts, in 2013, he also participated at the "6th International Conference on the Training of the Judiciary" organized by the International Organization for Judicial Training in USA. In 2014, he led a Bangladesh delegation in a visit to Hong Kong and China where the delegation participated at different sessions with the Vice-President of the Court of Appeal of the High Court of Hong Kong, Vice-President of the Supreme People`s Court of China, National Judges College China and High Court of Beijing. He has visited India, Nepal, Qatar, South Korea, Singapore, Thailand, Indonesia, Malaysia, Hong Kong, China, United States, United Kingdom and Canada.

HONOURABLE MR. JUSTICE T.S. Thakur -CHIEF JUSTICE OF INDIA

Hon`ble Justice T.S. Thakur was Born on 04th January, 1952. He was enrolled as a Pleader in October, 1972 and joined the Chamber of his father Late Shri D.D. Thakur, a leading Advocate and later, a Judge of High Court of J & K. He practised in Civil, Criminal, Constitutional, Taxation and Service matters in the High Court of Jammu & Kashmir. He was designated as a Senior Advocate in the year 1990. He was appointed as an Additional Judge of the High Court of J & K on 16th February, 1994 and transferred as Judge of

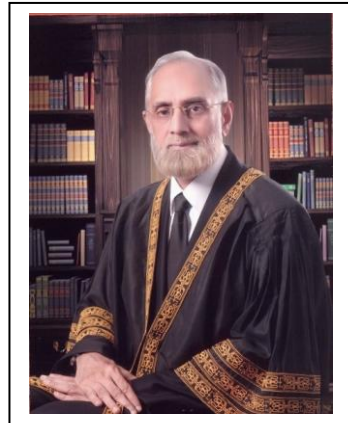


the High Court of Karnataka in March, 1994. He was appointed as a permanent Judge in September, 1995. He was transferred as a Judge of the High Court of Delhi in July 2004. He was appointed as Acting Chief Justice of Delhi High Court on 09.04.2008 and took over as Chief Justice of the High Court of Punjab and Haryana on August 11, 2008. He elevated as Judge of Supreme Court and assumed charge on 17.11.2009.

HONOURABLE MR. JUSTICE ANWAR ZAHEER JAMALI -CHIEF JUSTICE OF PAKISTAN

Hon'ble Mr. Justice Anwar Zaheer Jamali, hails from noble religious family of Hazrat Qutub Jamal-ud-Din Ahmed Hansvi (583-659 A.H.), the disciple and Khalifa of Baba Farid-ud-Din Shakar Gunj of Pakpattan, belonging to the Chistia Order of Mystics, parents migrated in the year 1947 from Jaipur, India. Born at Hyderabad (Sindh) on 31.12.1951; completed the Bachelor's Degree in Commerce and the Bachelor's Degree in Law from University of Sindh in the years 1971 and 1973 respectively; enrolled at Sindh Bar Council as an Advocate of Lower Court on 10.01.1975, admitted and enrolled as an Advocate of High Court on 13.11.1977; admitted and enrolled as an Advocate of Supreme Court on 14.05.1987; practiced at Hyderabad (Sindh) mainly on civil and constitutional side;



His lordship was elected as President District Bar Association Hyderabad in the years 1983-84, 1995-96, 1996-97 and 1997-98; elected as Member, Sindh Bar Council from Hyderabad Division for two terms of five years each in the years 1989 and 1994; elected as Chairman Benevolent Fund Committee of Sindh Bar Council in the year 1991; elected as Chairman Executive Committee of Sindh Bar Council in the year 1995 and held this position till his elevation to the Bench; also remained member of several other sub-committees formed by the Sindh Bar Council; remained office bearer of several other social, educational and human rights organizations at Hyderabad and attended their legal work on honorary basis.

His lordship's love & affection with legal knowledge persuaded him to join Hyderabad (Sindh) Law College as Lecturer in the year 1984, where he served in that capacity for about two years; worked as counsel for UBL for about ten years and Legal Advisor of Catholic Board of Education and Saint Bonaventure's High School, Hyderabad for over ten years.

Mr. Justice Anwar Zaheer Jamali was elevated as Judge of High Court of Sindh in May, 1998, also nominated as Administrative Judge, High Court of Sindh with effect from 07.06.2006 and continued as such till 03.11.2007 when he refused to take fresh oath under the Provisional Constitution Order No: 1 of 2007. Reappointed as Judge and Chief Justice High Court of Sindh on 27.08.2008 and elevated as Judge of Supreme Court on 03.08.2009.

His lordship was also nominated by the Governor of Sindh as Member Board of Governors for the Government Law College in Sindh (excluding Karachi) in the year 1995; nominated by the Chief Justice, Sindh High Court, as Member Syndicate NED University of Engineering and Technology, Karachi in November 1999; nominated by the Chief Justice, Sindh High Court as Chairman Enrollment Committee, Sindh Bar Council in March 2000; nominated by the Governor of Sindh as Chairman Provincial Zakat Council Sindh for a term of three years in December 2003.
