Synopsis:

Hon'ble Mr. Justice Ranjan Gogoi is an Indian judge serving as the 46th and current Chief Justice of India since 3 October 2018.

Birth & Early Life:

Hon'ble Mr. Justice Ranjan Gogoi was Born on 18th November, 1954, at Dibrugarh, Assam, India. His father Keshab Chandra Gogoi was a Chief minister under the Indian National Congress regime in the state of Assam in the year 1982. He is the first person from Northeast India and first Assamese to become Chief Justice of India.

Education:

Mr. Gogoi completing schooling at Don Bosco in Dibrugarh before moving to Delhi for pre-university and graduate studies. He graduated from St. Stephen's College, Delhi with honours in History. Later did post graduation from Delhi University and Law from Delhi University

Legal Experience:

Justice Ranjan Gogoi Joined the Bar in 1978. He Practised mainly in the Gauhati High Court.

Career as an Honourable Judge:

Justice Ranjan Gogoi Appointed as Permanent Judge of Gauhati High Court on 28th February, 2001. He Transferred to Punjab & Haryana High Court on 9th September, 2010. He Appointed as Chief Justice of Punjab & Haryana High Court on 12th February, 2011. He Elevated as Judge of the Supreme Court on 23rd April, 2012. He Appointed as The Chief Justice of India on 03.10.2018. On 3 October 2018, he took the oath of office of the chief justice of India, thus succeeding Dipak Misra.
